




- The competition is open to all individuals (students, professionals, etc.).
- Participants must register prior to the event.
- No team participation is allowed; this is an individual competition.

2. Materials Provided by the Organizer:

• Paper: The organizers will provide A3-size paper for all participants.

3. Materials to be Brought by Participants:

- Participants must bring their own sketching materials, including:
- Pencils (graphite, charcoal, colored pencils, etc.)
- Erasers
- Blending tools (optional)
- Ruler, compass, or other tools for precision (optional)
- Use of only traditional sketching tools is allowed (no digital or painting mediums).

4. Competition Format:

- The theme of the competition is "Greatest Leader of India, Scientist, and Mathematician of the Nation."
- Participants must create a portrait of a person who fits within one of these categories (e.g., Mahatma Gandhi, APJ Abdul Kalam, Srinivasa Ramanujan, etc.).
- Participants are free to choose anyone within these categories (historical or contemporary figures).
- Students should carry their university ID cards with them at the venue of the competition

5. Time Limit:

- 2 hours will be given to complete the sketch.
- Time management is crucial. No extra time will be provided beyond the stipulated 2 hours.

• WASTE TO WONDER COMPETITION RULEBOOK

1. Participation

- The competition is open to individual participants.
- Participants must bring their own waste materials to create their DIY projects (e.g., plastic bottles, newspapers, cardboard, etc.).
- The following materials will be provided by the organizers:
- Fevicol (20 mg)
- Colors
- Brush
- Cutter
- Participants may also bring their own additional materials (paints, decorative items, adhesives, etc.) if desired.

<u>2. Theme</u>

- The theme of the competition is "Waste to Wonder".
- Participants must create a useful or decorative item using recyclable waste materials.
- The final product should showcase creativity and innovation in reusing waste materials.

<u>3. Time Limit</u>

- Participants will have 90 minutes to complete their DIY projects.
- The countdown will start as soon as the competition begins, and no extra time will be given.

4. Rules for DIY Project

- Participants must use waste materials they bring themselves as the core elements of their project.
- The use of provided materials (Fevicol, colors, brush, cutter) is mandatory, but participants are free to bring additional tools and materials for enhancing their projects.
- No pre-assembled items are allowed; everything must be created during the competition.
- The project should not exceed a size that makes it difficult to display or judge effectively.
- Students should carry their university ID cards with them at the venue of the competition

Rules & Regulations

1. Participation

- The competition is open to individual participants only.
- The following materials will be provided by the organizers:
- MDF board
- Colors (basic colours)
- Fevicol (20 mg)
- Brush
- Cutter

2. Theme

- Participants must create a Lippan art piece on the provided MDF board within the given time frame.
- The art must reflect traditional Lippan motifs or designs, but can include modern interpretations to showcase creativity.

<u>3. Time Limit</u>

- Participants will have 2 hours to complete their Lippan art.
- Time starts as soon as the competition begins, and no extra time will be given.

4. Rules for Artwork

- The artwork must be created only on the provided MDF board.
- Use of provided colors, Fevicol, cutter, and brush is mandatory, though participants are free to use their own tools in addition to those provided.
- Participants are allowed to bring their own Lippan tool kit, but no pre-made designs or pre-cut materials are permitted.
- No artificial embellishments, mirrors, or beads may be used in the artwork unless specified by the organizers.
- Students should carry their university ID cards with them at the venue of the competition.

Rules & Regulations 1. Participation

- The competition is open to individuals or teams of two.
- Colours will be provided by the organizers.
- Participants should also bring their own painting supplies (paints, brushes, sponges, etc.).
- Only non-toxic, skin-safe face paints are allowed. No harmful materials should be used on the skin.

<u>2. Theme</u>

- The theme of the competition is "Animal Kingdom."
- Participants must create face art inspired by any animal of their choice (real or imaginary).
- The artwork should reflect creativity, originality, and adherence to the theme.

<u>3. Time Limit</u>

- Participants will have 2 hours to complete their face painting.
- Time starts as soon as the competition begins, and no extra time will be given.

<u>4. Judging Criteria</u>

- Creativity and Originality: Innovative and imaginative designs.
- Relevance to the Theme: How well the design represents the chosen animal.
- Skill and Technique: Precision, use of colors, shading, and artistic techniques.
- Overall Aesthetic Appeal: The final look and visual impact of the face painting.

5. Rules for Face Painting

- Participants can paint only on the face. Use of neck and shoulders is optional.
- No stencils or pre-drawn templates are allowed; everything must be done freehand.
- Participants can use mirrors while painting but cannot seek help from others.
- No artificial decorations, attachments, or props allowed (e.g., feathers, jewels).

6. Disqualification

- Any participant found not adhering to the rules, using unsafe materials, or receiving outside help will be disqualified.
- Plagiarism (copying a known design without significant modification) will lead to disqualification.

<u>7. Submission</u>

- Once the time is up, participants must stop working and present their designs to the judges.
- Judging will take place immediately after the time limit is over.

6. THE PARTICIPANTS WILL CARRY THEIR OWN WATER BOTTLE, DRAWING MATERIAL AND ROUGH CLOTH FOR CLEANING.

7. EVALUATION WILL BASED ON THE THEME, QUALITY OF WORK, ITS ARTISTIC JUDGES EVALUATION.

8. PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATES WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL THE PARTICIPANTS.
